



Article 01 ELECTION

To choose all necessary Town Officers for the ensuing year.

Article 02 ZONING AMENDMENTS

To see if the town will vote to amend the Wilmot Planning and Zoning Ordinance by adopting the amendments specified on the town voting day ballot.

Article 03 GENERAL MUNICIPAL OPERATIONS

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of one million nine hundred sixty-two thousand and one hundred and five dollars (\$1,962,105) for general municipal operations. This article does not include special or individual articles addressed. (Majority vote required) – Recommended by the Selectboard – by unanimous vote.

Article 04 PAVING ETF

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to be placed in the Paving Fund Expendable Trust Fund established in 2007 for said purpose. (Majority vote required) – Recommended by the Selectboard – by unanimous vote.

Article 05 PAVING TOWN-OWNED ROADS

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of one hundred eighty thousand dollars (\$180,000) for the purpose of paving town-owned roads. The sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to come from the Paving Fund Expendable Trust Fund previously established for said purpose and the remaining one hundred and thirty thousand (\$130,000) to come from general taxation. This is a non-lapsing article and will not lapse until the paving work is complete or 12/31/2026, whichever is sooner. (Majority vote required) – Recommended by the Selectboard – by unanimous vote.

Article 06 PURCHASE HIGHWAY VEHICLE (GRADER)

To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of four hundred and five thousand dollars (\$405,000) for the purchase and outfitting of a new highway vehicle (grader) with one hundred and sixty thousand dollars (\$160,000) to come from taxation, one hundred and ninety thousand dollars (\$190,000) to come from the Equipment Capital Reserve Fund established for said purpose, and up to fifty-five thousand dollars (\$55,000) to come from the unassigned fund balance. This is a non-lapsing article and will not lapse until the grader transaction is completed or 12/31/2026, whichever is sooner. (Majority vote required) - Recommended by the Selectboard - by unanimous vote.

Article 07 FUND CAPITAL UPGRADES TO TOWN HALL/LIBRARY COMPLEX

To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of thirty-nine thousand and six hundred dollars (\$39,600) for capital upgrades to the Town Hall/Library complex and authorize the use of fourteen thousand and six hundred dollars (\$14,600) from the unassigned fund balance and the withdrawal of up to twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) from the Town Facility Capital Reserve created for said purpose. (Majority vote required) -- Recommended by the Selectboard -- by unanimous vote.

Article 08 FIRE TRUCK CRF

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) to be placed in the Fire Truck Capital Reserve Fund for the replacement of a fire truck. (Majority vote required) – Recommended by the Selectboard – by unanimous vote.



Article 09 FIRE DEPARTMENT SCBA AND RADIO CRF

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) to be placed in the Fire Department SCBA and Radio Capital Reserve Fund for the purpose of replacing self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA) packs and two-way radios. (Majority vote required) – Recommended by the Selectboard – by unanimous vote.

Article 10 POLICE VEHICLE CRF

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000) to be placed in the Police Vehicle Capital Reserve Fund for the purpose of purchasing a police vehicle. (Majority vote required.) Recommended by the Selectboard - by unanimous vote.

Article 11 TOWN REVALUATION CRF

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of nine thousand dollars (\$9,000) to be placed in the Town Revaluation Capital Reserve Fund established in 2001 for said purpose. (Majority vote required) – Recommended by the Selectboard – by unanimous vote.

Article 12 TOWN FACILITY CRF

To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) to be added to the Town Facility Capital Reserve Fund previously established. (Majority vote required) -- Recommended by the Selectboard -- by unanimous vote.

Article 13 BRIDGE CRF

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) to be placed in the Bridge Capital Reserve Fund, established for the purposes of maintaining and repairing Wilmot's bridges. (Majority vote required) – Recommended by the Selectboard – by unanimous vote.

Article 14 TOWN FACILITY PRE-CONSTRUCTION CRF

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) to be placed in the Town Facility Pre-Construction Capital Reserve Fund previously established. (Majority vote required) – Recommended by the Selectboard – by unanimous vote.

Article 15 MASTER PLAN ETF

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500) to be placed in the Master Plan Expendable Trust Fund, established in 2017 for said purpose. (Majority vote required) – Recommended by the Selectboard – by unanimous vote.

Article 16 BUILDING MAINTENANCE & REPAIRS FUND

To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) to be added to the Building Maintenance and Repairs Non-capital Reserve Fund previously established under RSA 35:1-c. This sum to come from unassigned fund balance. No amount to be raised from taxation. (Majority vote required) -- Recommended by the Selectboard -- by unanimous vote.



Article 17 UNANTICIPATED TECHNOLOGY EXPENSE FUND ETF

To see if the town will vote to establish the Unanticipated Technology Expense Fund ETF per RSA 31:19-a, for the purpose of providing the Town with unanticipated services, equipment and materials for electronic information storage and/or retrieval and communications and to appropriate nine thousand dollars (\$9,000) from the unassigned fund balance . No amount to be raised from taxation; further to name the selectboard as agents to expend from said fund. (Majority vote required) - Recommended by the Selectboard - by unanimous vote.

Article 18 TECHNOLOGY FUND EXPENDABLE TRUST - DISCONTINUE

Upon the recommendation of the Wilmot Selectboard to see if the town will vote to discontinue the Technology Fund Expendable Trust created in 2014. Said funds, with accumulated interest to date of withdrawal (approximately \$9,008 dollars), are to be transferred to the municipality's general fund. (Majority vote required) - Recommended by the Selectboard - by unanimous vote.

Article 19 WILMOT VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPT OPERATING BUDGET

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of sixty-seven thousand dollars (\$67,000) for the purpose of funding operations for the Wilmot Volunteer Fire Department. (Majority vote required) – Recommended by the Selectboard – by unanimous vote.

Article 20 AMBULANCE SERVICE

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of thirty five thousand and thirty dollars (\$35,030) for the purpose of supporting and funding services of the New London Hospital Ambulance. (Majority vote required) – Recommended by the Selectboard – by unanimous vote.

Article 21 WILMOT LEARNING PLACE

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of four thousand two hundred and fifty dollars (\$4,250) for the purpose of supporting The Wilmot Learning Place. (Majority vote required) – Recommended by the Selectboard – by unanimous vote.

Article 22 COMMUNITY ACTION PROGRAM

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of four thousand six hundred dollars (\$4,600) for the purpose of supporting and funding the services of the Community Action Program. (Majority vote required) – Recommended by the Selectboard – by unanimous vote.

Article 23 WILMOT COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of five thousand four hundred dollars (\$5,400) for the purpose of supporting The Wilmot Community Association. (Majority vote required) – Recommended by the Selectboard – by unanimous vote.

Article 24 LAKE SUNAPEE REGION VNA

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of four thousand eighty dollars (\$4,080) for the purpose of supporting and funding the services of the Lake Sunapee Region Visiting Nurse Association. (Majority vote required) – Recommended by the Selectboard – by unanimous vote.



Article 25 COUNCIL ON AGING

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of the three thousand one hundred ninety dollars (\$3,190) for the purpose of supporting and funding the services of the Kearsarge Area Council on Aging. (Majority vote required) – Recommended by the Selectboard – by unanimous vote.

Article 26 CASA (COURT APPOINTED SPECIAL ADVOCATES)

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) for the purpose of supporting and funding the services of CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocates) for children. (Majority vote required) – Recommended by the Selectboard – by unanimous vote.

Article 27 WILMOT HISTORICAL SOCIETY TO LEASE TOWN LAND

To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Wilmot Selectboard to enter into an agreement with the Wilmot Historical Society to lease a portion of town-owned land at 14 North Wilmot Road for the purpose of constructing an historically appropriate building, with a footprint of approximately 30' x 60', to house its collection and make it available to the public. This agreement will be contingent upon the findings of an engineering study and other pertinent factors. PETITIONED ARTICLE.

Article 28 ANY OTHER BUSINESS

To transact any other business that may come before said meeting.
